

Kletterrosen (Climber)



'FUTÓTÜZ' ('WILDFIRE')

Height: 2-3 m.

Habit: Climber.

Flowers: Semi-double, 12 cm across, fiery red.

Scent: Lightly fragrant.

Leaves: Mid-green, large, very glossy.

Blooming period: Blooming almost continuously from first half of June to autumn.

Tips: Shows good disease resistance, tolerates dry weather, it is frost resistant.

Parentage: 'Don Juan' x 'Paul's Scarlet Climber'.

Origin: G. Márk, Hungary, 1991, ® 1995.



'MAROSVÉCS'

Height: 2-2.5 m.

Habit: Vigorous, slow-growing climber.

Flowers: Double, 7-8 cm across, with character reflecting similarity to Hybrid Tea roses.

Scent: Fragrant.

Leaves: Light green, small, matt.

Blooming period: Blooming almost continuously from early-May to autumn.

Tips: Shows good disease resistance, tolerates dry weather, it is frost resistant.

Parentage: 'Esztergom' x 'Clg. Sutter's Gold'.

Origin: G. Márk, Hungary, 1991.



'ROZÁLIA'

Height: 2.5-3 m.

Habit: Climber.

Flowers: Double, Hybrid Tea-like, 8-10 cm across, orange ageing pinkish.

Scent: Moderately strong.

Leaves: Light green, mid-sized, semi-glossy.

Blooming period: Blooming almost continuously from mid-May to autumn.

Tips: Shows good disease resistance, tolerates dry weather, it is frost resistant.

Parentage: 'Körösi Csoma Sándor' x 'Clg. Sutter's Gold'.
