### 'BUDATÉTÉNY'

**Height:** 70-80 cm.

**Habit:** Upright, slightly spreading.

**Flowers:** Double, 12 cm across, peachy-pink, with red streaks.

**Scent:** Fragrant.

**Leaves:** Light mid-green, mid-sized, glossy.

**Blooming period:** Blooming continuously from first half of June to autumn.

**Tips:** Shows good disease resistance, tolerates dry weather, it is exceptionally frost resistant. Good for cutting and bedding.

**Parentage:** 'Planten un Blomen' x 'Golden Masterpiece'.

### 'CSOBÁNC'

**Height:** 60-70 cm.

**Habit:** Loosely spreading.

**Flowers:** Double, 7 cm across, light salmon-pink.

**Scent:** Very light.

**Leaves:** Mid-green, mid-sized, matt.

**Blooming period:** Blooming from mid-May to first frosts in autumn.

**Tips:** Shows good disease resistance, tolerates dry weather, it is frost resistant. Good for bedding.

**Parentage:** 'Pink Favorit' x 'Budatétény'

### 'LISZKA JENŐ EMLÉKE' (IN MEMORIAM JENŐ LISZKA)'

**Height:** 70-80 cm.

**Habit:** Upright, moderately spreading.

**Flowers:** Double, 10 cm across, purplish-pink.

**Scent:** Lightly fragrant.

**Leaves:** Mid-green, large, semi-glossy.

**Blooming period:** Blooming almost continuously from first half of June to frosts.

**Tips:** Shows good disease resistance, tolerates dry weather, it is frost resistant. Good for cutting and bedding.

**Parentage:** 'Sasad F<sub>1</sub>'.

### 'TOKAJ'

**Height:** 60-70 cm.

**Habit:** Moderately spreading.

**Flowers:** Double, 8 cm across, orangey-pink.

**Scent:** Lightly fragrant.

**Leaves:** Light green, glossy.

**Blooming period:** Blooming almost continuously from first half of June to autumn.

**Tips:** Shows good disease resistance, tolerates dry weather, it is frost resistant. Good for cutting and bedding.

**Parentage:** 'Kalotaszeg' x 'Simmelweis Ignác emléke'.
